Korean Language course

Korean Language Institute (KLI) of Hongik University was established in March 2002 with the goal of cultivating global people of capability and talent, and continues to devotedly promote Korean language education, focusing on students' needs. Regular course of Korean language institute runs 4 semesters per year, and currently students from all over the world including China, Japan, the United States, and Europe are mastering the Korean language and learning about Korean culture through this program.



Student Exchange / Study Abroad Program

Hongik University is delighted to host exchange students from partner universities. Duration of the exchange program is generally one semester.

Students who are not from our partner universities are welcome to study at Hongik University as visiting students. Duration of the visiting program is generally one semester.



Hongik International Summer School

Hongik International Summer School offers students from around the world a wonderful experience with credit-bearing subject at Hongik University, Seoul. The program includes industry linked lectures and various field trips in Seoul.



Support for International Students

On-Campus Dormitory

24 floors of hotel-style dormitory rooms with a view of the Han River, student cafeteria, student support facilities, study rooms, and a culture and sports complex.

International Student Lounge

The International Student Lounge in the main campus is equipped with computers, sightseeing information and magazines, coffee and snacks, foreign newspapers and more for foreign students.

Student Buddies

Local students are assigned as buddies for foreign students to help them with school and overall life in Korea.

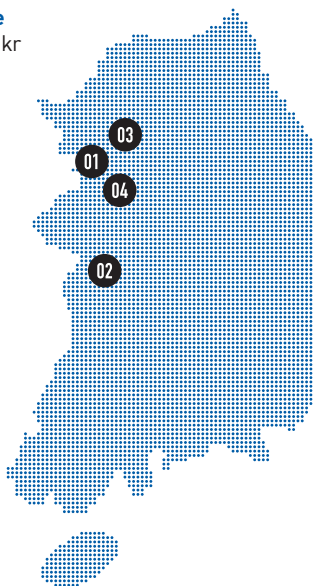
