Introduction

- Vision College of Jeonju is located in Jeonju City, which is two and a half hours away from Seoul, the capital of South Korea.
- Vision College of Jeonju, is founded in 1976, consists of a total of 3,500 students, 300 faculty members, and 22 departments which have 2year, 3year and 4year course.
- Most of the classes consist of practice class.

Students can graduate after two years or continue to study in the third grades.

In addition, from third grade, students can work during the day and take classes at night.

- Since Vision college is located in the center of the city, there are a lot of places where can do various part-time jobs nearby. It can solve financial difficulties because international students can work while studying in the college.

Departments

- The department consists of 2, 3, 4 year courses. After completing the two-year course, students get an associate's degree. Or if students study continuously in the third and fourth grades, a bachelor's degree is granted after graduation.
- TOPIK Level 3 is required to enter the college.

Korean language course

- There is Korean Language Course for foreign students who need to learn Korean. Students can enter the college course after completing the Korean language course for 6months ~ 2years.
- Korean Language Course begins four times a year in March, June, September and December.
- Korean Language Course is conducted for 4 hours a day, 5 days a week (Monday to Friday), and 10 weeks a semester.
- Korean Cultural Experience and Visiting program for Korean Companies are conducted during Korean Language course.

Other

- Vision College of Jeonju has the highest employment rate for international students in Korea. Every year 50 to 70 of the graduating students are employed (with E-7 visa) by Korean companies (annual income - more than 30 million won)

It is very difficult for international students to get a job in Korea after graduation. Currently, there are 150,000~160,000 international students in Korea and about 35,000 international students graduate every year. Among them, fewer than 300 students are employed in Korea.

- International students who graduated from the Department of Automobile, Architecture, Mechanics, Electricity (New & Renewable Energy) are eligible for employment in Korean companies.
- As of 2021, 58% of the graduates were employed by Korean companies.
- Providing international students with basic education for employment (computer, writing a resume, writing self-introduction, preparing for a job interview and job etiquette etc.)
