Dong-eui University took its first step as Kyung-dong Engineering Technical College in 1977, which was later reorganized as Dong-eui College in 1979 and officially authorized as a four-year university in 1983.

Currently, Dong-eui University has grown into a comprehensive university with 8 colleges departments, 19 divisions, 3595 admission capacities, 7 graduate schools and 153 master and doctoral courses.

Recently, about 16,000 enrolled students and 1,600 staff are working on academic research and community service.





Admissions Eligibility



1) Nationality : Both applicant's parents are not citizens of Korea
(Except for persons who have multiple nationalities)

2) Level of Education

Newly admitted for undergraduate course	Applicant must complete elementary, middle and high school courses (12 years) in Korea or abroad. ※ Prospective graduating students also must complete elementary, middle and high school courses (12 years) in Korea or abroad.
Transfer for undergraduate course	Students who have completed 2 academic years at another 4-year university in Korea or abroad or students who have graduated from a 2-year college. ※ Prospective graduating students who will complete 2 academic years at another 4-year university in Korea or abroad or prospective students who will graduate from a 2-year college.
Graduate course (Master)	Students who have acquired bachelor's degree
Graduate course (Doctoral)	Students who have acquired master's degree


※ Documents written in a foreign language other than Korean or English must be notarized and translated into Korean or English.

Application Procedure



- 1) **Document examination** : Submitted documents of applicant are examined synthetically.
- 2) **Interview** : After examination of documents, applicants are divided into those who stay in Korea and those who do not stay in Korea by recruitment unit.
- 3) **Announcement of admissions decision** : Successful applicants will be announced on a website or personally informed.

2) Graduate school – Special Scholarship for foreigner

- 50% of tuition fee will be provided for the first year (2 semesters)
- After the first year (2 semesters), if students acquire TOPIK level 3 or higher, 50% of tuition fee will be maintained and expanded.
- After the first year (2 semesters), if students acquire TOPIK level 2 or lower, 50% of tuition fee will be reduced and excluded automatically.

※ Other scholarships : Scholarships for TOPIK improvement, Foreigner diversify scholarship, Service scholarship for foreigner.
