Admission Procedure

Step1: Go on the KHCU admission website and complete the application form

Step2: Pay for application fee (waived for foreigners)

Step3: Fill out personal statement

Step4: Take personality test

Step5: Submit documents for admission by post/visit

Step6: Check successful candidate announcement, and pay for admission fee

Step7: Make student ID number

Step8: Register the courses and pay for tuition fee

- 1st round : June 1, 2021 ~ July 13, 2021

- 2nd round : July 23, 2021 ~ August 17, 2021

Screening Standards (100 points)

- Personal Statement [personal background and advantages working experiences, reason of application]: 80 points
- Personality test [standard personality test, 50 MCs]: 20 points

• Freshmen: High school graduates or above

- Transfer(Sophomore)
- 1) Graduate from a foreign community college and holder of an associate degree
- 2) Completed freshmen year at a foreign 4-years college/university (including graduates)

Admission Requirements

• Transfer(Junior)

- 1) Graduate from a foreign community college and holder of an associate degree
- 2) Completed sophomore year at a foreign 4-years college/university (including graduates)
- It is mandatory to obtain at least 1/2 or more of the minimum credits needed for a bachelor's degree, and relevant documents are needed to be submitted.

- Official high school graduation certificate
- Certificate of final education

- Agreement for enrollment and academic record (Applicants can download on KHCU's admission website)

- Apostille or Education qualification certificate(confirmed by embassy)

- Previous college academic transcript
