

# Honam University Admission Guide for International Students

## ◎HU Korean Language Center

### ○ Qualifications and Documents

1. Qualification: students with high a school diploma or equivalent education within recent 2 years after graduation.
  2. Documents to be submitted
    - 1) One Completed Application Form (HU form)
    - 2) Letter of Guarantee (HU form)
    - 3) Certificate of graduation
    - 4) School transcript (with GPA)
- \*\* for documents of 3, 4
- Original documents must be submitted after admission acceptance confirmation
  - Submit Certification after translated into Korean or English version of notarized documents
  - Degree should be confirmed by the Korean embassy
- 5) A copy of Applicant's passport
  - 6) Evidence of parenthood and non-Korean citizenship (All documents need to be translated either in Korean / English) - Family Relation Certificate
  - 7) Bank verification letter showing access to at least \$10,000 USD
  - 8) Financial Sponsor Agreement and/or Official Statement of Finances

### ○ Cost

1. Tuition fee: KR 2,400,000 won / two semesters(20weeks, 400hrs.)  
( approximately USD 2,300)
2. Application fee: KR 50,000 won ( app. USD 50)
3. Dormitory fee: KR 1,207,000 won / 16 weeks ( app. USD 1,000)

\* Above dormitory fee could be more or less depend on the applicant's departure time. During semester period of university academic schedule, students pay for four month fee including breakfast and supper and during vacation period, students pay for 10 weeks fee excluding meals. This information could be changed according to the university regulation later.

4. Health Insurance for International Student: KR 150,000 won per year (app. USD 150)

## ◎ Undergraduate Course Introduction and Scholarships

### 1. Qualifications

- 1) An applicant with non-Korean nationality and both parents also having non-Korean nationality
- 2) For Freshmen, Foreign students who completed or expected to complete secondary education before admission
- 3) For Transfer, Foreign students who completed secondary education and expected to complete 2 years at a 4-year university, or to graduate from a two or three year junior college.
- 4) Standard Test of Proficiency in Korean above level(TOPIK) 3

### 2. Documents

- 1) One Completed Application Form (HU form)
  - 2) Letter of Guarantee (HU form)
  - 3) Certificate of graduation
  - 4) School transcript (with GPA)
- \*\* for documents of 3, 4
- Original documents must be submitted after admission acceptance confirmation
  - Submit Certification after translated into Korean or English version of notarized documents
  - Degree should be confirmed by the Korean embassy
- 5) A copy of Applicant's passport
  - 6) Evidence of parenthood and non-Korean citizenship (All documents need to be translated either in Korean / English) - Family Relation Certificate
  - 7) Bank verification letter showing access to at least \$18,000 USD
  - 8) Financial Sponsor Agreement and/or Official Statement of Finances
